## voice and organ

with a very slowly unfolding chord (slow arpeggio) the organ opens a wide space and invites the voice to enter. at the end of the phrase the organ concludes while the chord disappears (slow arpeggio again).

during the following silence the organ might play (but must not) a humble, inconspicuous, and weak echo of the voice (fragments, some poor tones or even one single tone).

then the organ opens again the space with the next chord (arpeggio as before), the voice enters with the next phrase, the organ concludes. both remain silent: the organ thinking about the echo, the voice waiting if an echo will arise or not. in this way the two continue until the piece concludes with the disappearance of the last chord and the following silence (with or without an echo).

## voice

line above a syllable: change of the pitch; higher.

line below a syllable: change of the pitch; lower.

no line: the syllable keeps the same pitch as the syllable before.

ightharpoonup : melisma. sing the same syllable with higher or lower pitch.

in case there is no line above or below this sign the sign means a lengthening.

## organ

chords (see messiaen's mode 2): a combination of the various colors or a single color of the rich 8 foot (and/or 16 foot) stops. the color changes from chord to chord.

any order of the tones of one chord (appearing and disappearing).

any distribution on the manuals and the pedal.

any octaves of each tone.

echo: a faint voice (perhaps one very soft reed – or a 4 foot or even 2 foot stop – or a soft combination – or another solo voice  $(2^2/_3 \text{ or } 1^3/_5)$ . any octaves.
