the left hand is pumping while the right hand plays on the keyboard.

there are no notes for pitches, but fingerings for places on the keyboard.

1: thumb; 2: forefinger; 3: middle finger; 4: ring finger; 5: little finger.

A: a rather wide ambitus; the right hand is more or less outstretched.

a: a rather small ambitus: the fingers are more or less drawn tight.

●: a single tone (any finger).

beginning with “chords – dyads – singles tones (I)”, then continuing with some melodies (page “melodies” – in any order). coming back to the pages chords, playing “chords – dyads – singles tones (II)”, then continuing with some melodies. coming back to the pages chords, playing “chords – dyads – singles tones (III)”, continuing with some melodies – and so on.

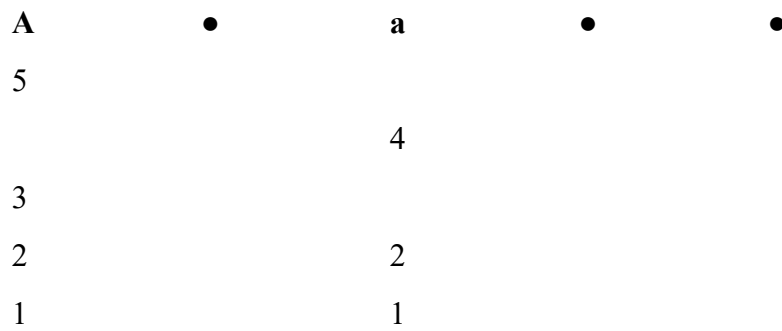

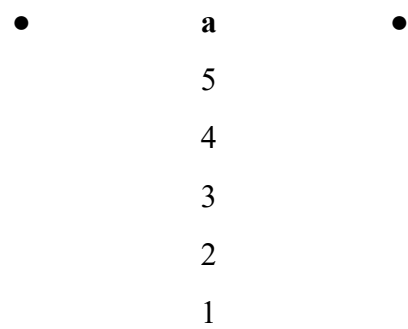

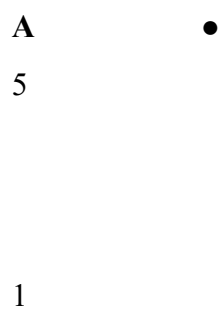
